

A Public Questionnaire about Pedlars:

The government is considering alteration to pedlar legislation and is gathering evidence through Durham University to help formulate policy that reflects the General Interest. Powerful lobby groups seek legislation to restrict the rights of pedlars by prohibiting pedlar's lawful activity on the street and circulating slur & smear about pedlars, seeking to achieve restraint-of-trade that forces pedlars to go only door-to-door.
