POSSIBLE CHAIRMAN'S STATEMENT

All the Bill except clause 5 survived as drafted
 Clause 5 needs amendment.

The pedlar trading house to house survived
 For those not trading house to house —

- their goods or tools of handicraft must be carried on foot on the person or in a trolley pushed or pulled by the person with a carrying capacity of no more than 1 cubic metre subject to next point
- they will not stop in one place for more than 5 minutes
- they must travel at least 200 metres interrupted only by stops for a specific sale
- they cannot return to within 5m of any of their previous spots in a 12 hour period
- they cannot move to a position within 25m of another ~~the~~ pedlar ~~with~~ with the same authority
- they must display their certificate prominently

~~that shall be~~ pedlers

The exception for those not trading from house to house is to be qualified to the effect that nothing in it shall be taken to extend the range of activities comprising acting as a pedlar.
