### Possible Chairman's Statement

All the Bill except clause 5 survives as drafted  
Clause 5 needs amendment.

The pedlar trading house to house survives

For those not trading house to house -

- Their goods or tools of handicraft must be carried on foot on the person or in a trolley pushed or pulled by the person with a carrying capacity of no more than 1 cubic metre
- They must not stop in one place for more than 5 minutes subject to the next point,
- They must then move on at least 200 metres interrupted only by stops for a specific sale
- They cannot return to within 5m of any of their previous spots in a 12 hour period
- They cannot move to a position within ~~200~~ <sup>100</sup> m of another ~~the~~ pedlar ~~with~~ the same authority
- They must display their certificates prominently

~~that must be~~ pedlars

The exception for those ~~not trading from house to house~~ is to be qualified to the effect that ~~nothing~~ <sup>nothing</sup> in it shall be taken to extend the range of activities comprising acting as a pedlar
